### FORT BEND COUNTY LEVEE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 14

The Board of Directors of Fort Bend County Levee Improvement District No. 14 will hold a regular meeting on **Monday, November 12, 2018, at 3:00 p.m.**, at One Avalon Place, Sugar Land, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:


1. Minutes of prior meeting(s).
2. Public comments.\*
3. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of bills, review of investments, and capital reserve.
4. Federal Emergency Management Agency applications for funding.
5. Tax assessment and collection matters, including payment of tax bills, delinquent tax collections, and installment agreements.
6. Matters pertaining to the City of Sugar Land.
7. Phase II MS4 Stormwater Plan implementation and stormwater permitting matters, including:
  - a. receive public comments;
  - b. adopt Resolution Adopting Stormwater Guidance Manual;
  - c. adopt Amended Order Establishing Rules and Penalties Regarding Use of District Rights of Way; and
  - d. approve language in the Operating Manual regarding Construction Site Operators and Storm Sewer Users.
8. Levee maintenance.
9. Landscape upgrade and lighting around picnic area and boat dock at The Brazos Landing.
10. Engineering matters, including approve plans and specifications and authorize advertisement for bids for construction projects, review bids and award contracts, and approve pay estimates, change orders, and final acceptance as appropriate, for construction projects, including:
  - a. deeds, easements, or consents to encroachment;
  - b. Reserve/Capital Improvement Project Spreadsheet;
  - c. possible levee improvement projects, including freeboard calculations;
  - d. pump station design, installation, review of engineering report, design and specifications and cost estimate related to the same;
  - e. review proposals for enhancement of existing pump station;
  - f. purchase and installation of Gator Pumps;
  - g. design and installation of sluice gates;

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\*An opportunity for the public to address the Board for items on or not on the agenda. All public must observe a three-minute time limit.

11. Review preliminary engineering report, cost estimates and financing for District projects and improvements and authorize engineer to proceed with necessary steps, including control staking, final design and construction phase services and project representative services.

    - a. update regarding re-capping in Ponds A and B;
    - b. update regarding weather station repair and approve Interlocal Agreement with City of Sugar Land for weather station repair and maintenance; and
    - c. Brazos River erosion monitoring.

  14. Perimeter levee inspection and meeting, levee and flood control conferences, common inspection and operation and maintenance, and Fort Bend Flood Management Association matters.
